

# Recycling & Refuse Collections Bank Holiday Changes

## Easter, May and August 2016

Usual collection day	Revised collection day
Good Friday 25 March	Saturday 26 March
Easter Monday 28 March - 1 April	All collections one day later, including Friday pick-ups on Saturday 2 April
Early May Bank Holiday Monday 2 May - Friday 6 May	All collections one day later, including Friday pick-ups on Saturday 7 May
Spring Bank Holiday Monday 30 May - Friday 3 June	All collections one day later, including Friday pick-ups on Saturday 4 June
Summer Bank Holiday Monday 29 August - Friday 2 September	All collections one day later, including Friday pick-ups on Saturday 3 September

No change to subsequent dates, all collections resume on usual days.

Revised collection days above also apply to  
**assisted, clinical waste and garden waste collections.**

### Recycling Sites

There are 14 Recycling Centres and two Community Recycling Sites throughout the county where a wide range of household materials can be recycled and other household waste deposited for disposal.

See our website for site locations, opening hours, materials recycled and lots more.

Centres are free to use for household waste, except Crewkerne and Dulverton, which have a £2 entry fee. At all centres, there are charges for disposal of asbestos, plasterboard, hardcore, soil, gas bottles and tyres.
