The Council is undertaking a review of its Local Plan (2006-2028) that was adopted for the area in March 2015.

The Local Plan Review 2016-2036 Preferred Options document identifies the proposed sites to be allocated new housing and employment development in South Somerset over the 20 years 2016 to 2036. It also includes the proposed polices against which planning applications will be assessed in the future.


Process timeline
