Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that Somerset County Council intends to make an order in pursuance of the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of motor vehicles on the lengths of road as detailed in the Schedule 1 of this Order. To introduce a temporary suspension of the One-Way Order, on the lengths of road detailed in Schedule 2 of this Order

The Order will be made to facilitate structural works and is in the interest of public safety.

The Order becomes effective on the 26th September 2019 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works will commence on the 30th September 2019 for 33 days. The restriction will apply when indicated by traffic signs.
